**A) QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEACHING STAFF OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL INSTITUTION
(For UG)**

(2) Professor:

(a) In Homoeopathic subjects namely, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine and Homeopathic Philosophy, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Homoeopathic Repertory and Case taking-

(i) Essential qualifications:

- (A) Recognised post-graduate degree in homoeopathy; and
(B) Not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned as an associate professor; or not less than ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution.
(C) Must have published two original publications as Principal author or Co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal.

(ii) Desirable qualifications:

- (A) Experience of not less than five years as supervisor or guide for post-graduate programme in Homoeopathy; and
- (B) Administrative experience of not less than three years in a homoeopathic medical college or hospital.
- (C) Research experience in a research institution recognised by the concerned University and or the State Government or Central Government or the Union territory administration, in a project registered with Clinical Trial Registry -India.
- (a) In allied subjects, namely, Human Anatomy, Human Physiology and Biochemistry, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Community Medicine, Research Methodology and Biostatistics, Practice of Medicine With Essentials of Pharmacology, Pathology and Microbiology, Surgery, Gynecology and Obstetrics-**

(i) Essential Qualification:

- (A) Post-graduate degree in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience as an Associate Professor in the subject concerned or not less than ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution; or
- (B) Post-graduate medical degree in the concerned subject recognised by the National Medical Commission with five years of teaching experience as an Associate Professor in the subject concerned or not less than ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a homoeopathic medical institution or in a medical college permitted by the Central Government; or
- (C) Recognised under graduate degree in homoeopathy along with post-graduate degree in medical anatomy for anatomy or in medical physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine (forensic medicine) for forensic Medicine and toxicology or in public health for community medicine from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission with twelve years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a homoeopathic medical institution; or
- (D) Recognised post-graduate degree in medical anatomy for anatomy or in physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine or forensic medicine for Forensic Medicine and Toxicology or in public health for community medicine along with Ph.D from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission with not less than twelve years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a homoeopathic medical institution; and
- (E) Must have published at least two original publications as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal.





(ii) Desirable Qualification:

- (A) Experience of not less than five years as supervisor or guide for post-graduate programme in Homoeopathy; and
- (B) Administrative experience of not less than three years in a homoeopathic medical college or hospital; and
- (C) Research experience in a research institution recognised by the concerned University or the State Government or Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.

(3) Associate Professor



- (A) Recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution;
- (B) Must have published at least one publication as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or
- (C) Recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy in subject concerned with not less than five years of full time research experience in Teaching Institution or in Research Council of the Central Government or State Government or Union territory Administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publication in indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission; or
- (D) Must have not less than five years of experience in regular service, after acquiring post-graduate degree in subject concerned in the Central Government Health Services or State Government Health services, Ministry of Ayush or full time five years of experience as medical officer in regular service after acquiring post-graduate degree in the concerned subject in recognised Homoeopathy Medical Institute and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission.

(ii) Desirable qualifications:

- (A) Experience of not less than three years as supervisor or co-supervisor or guide or co-guide for postgraduate course in homoeopathy; and
 - (B) Research experience in a research institution recognised by the concerned University or the State Government, Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.
- (b) In allied subjects, namely, Human Anatomy, Human Physiology and Biochemistry, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Community Medicine, Research Methodology and Biostatistics, Pathology and Microbiology, Surgery, Gynecology and Obstetrics**

(i) Essential qualification:

- (A) Recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of experience in regular service of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution;
- (B) Must have published at least one publication as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or

- (C) Post-graduate medical degree in the subject concerned recognised by the National Medical Commission with not less than five years of experience in regular service of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution or in a medical college permitted by the Central Government;
- (D) Must have published at least one publication as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or
- (E) Recognised under graduate qualification in homoeopathy and post-graduate degree in medical anatomy for anatomy or in medical physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine (forensic medicine) for forensic Medicine and toxicology or in public health for community medicine from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission with not less than seven years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution and;
- (F) Must have published one article as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or
- (G) Recognised post-graduate degree in medical anatomy for anatomy or physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine or forensic medicine for forensic Medicine and toxicology or in public health for community medicine along with Ph. OD from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission with not less than seven years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution; and
- (H) Must have published at least one article as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or
- (I) Recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with not less than five years of full time research experience in Teaching Institution or Research Council of the Central Government or State Government or Union territory Administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publication in indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission; and
- (J) at least three publications as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National teachers eligibility test conducted by the Commission; or
- (K) Must have five years of experience in regular service after acquiring post-graduate degree in the concerned subject in the Central Government Health Services or State Government Health services, Ministry of Ayush or full time five years of experience as medical officer in regular service after possessing Post-graduate degree in the subject concerned in recognised Homoeopathy Medical College and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission.

(ii) Desirable qualification:

- (A) Experience of not less than three years as supervisor or co-supervisor or guide or co-guide for postgraduate course in Homoeopathy; and
- (B) Research experience in a research institution recognised by the concerned University or the State Government or Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.

(4) Assistant Professor

- (a) In the subjects namely, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Repertory, and Practice of Medicines.-
Essential Qualification:



- (A) Recognised post-graduate degree in Homoeopathy in the subject concerned; and
- (B) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission. Preference shall be given to those candidates who holds experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a homoeopathic hospital attached to a homoeopathic medical institution permitted by the Central Government or Commission.

(b) In the subjects, namely, Anatomy, Physiology, Pathology, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Surgery, Gynecology and Obstetrics.-

Essential Qualification:

- (A) Recognised post-graduate degree in homoeopathy; and
- (B) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission and preference shall be given to those candidates who holds experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a homoeopathic hospital attached to a homoeopathic medical institution permitted by the Central Government or Commission; or
- (C) Post-graduate medical degree in subject concerned recognised by the National Medical Commission; and
- (D) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission and preference shall be given to those candidates who holds experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a hospital attached to a medical college permitted by the Central Government; or
- (E) Recognised under graduate degree in homoeopathy and post-graduate degree in medical anatomy for anatomy or in medical physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine (forensic medicine) for forensic Medicine and toxicology from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission; and
- (F) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission; or
- (G) Post-graduate degree in medical anatomy for anatomy or Physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine or forensic medicine for forensic medicine and toxicology from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission; and
- (H) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission.

(c) In the subject, namely, community medicine and research methodology and biostatistics.-

Essential Qualifications:

- (A) Recognised post-graduate degree in homoeopathy; and
- (B) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission and preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a homoeopathic hospital attached to a homoeopathic medical institution permitted by the Central Government or Commission;
- (C) Must have published at least two original publications as principal or co-author in peer reviewed journals; or
- (D) Recognised under graduate degree in homoeopathy and post-graduate degree in public health for community medicine from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission; and
- (E) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission; or
- (F) Post-graduate degree in public health for community medicine along with Ph.D from recognised University or medical institution as recognised by the National Medical Commission; and
- (G) Qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission.



(d) **Visiting Assistant Professor In Fundamentals Of Psychology.-**

Essential Qualifications:

- (A) Recognised post-graduate degree in Homoeopathy and Masters degree in any branch of psychology and preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a homoeopathic hospital attached to a homoeopathic medical institution permitted by the Central Government or Commission; or
- (B) Recognised post-graduate degree in homoeopathy in psychiatry and preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a homoeopathic hospital attached to a homoeopathic medical institution permitted by the Central Government or Commission; or
- (C) Post-graduate medical degree in psychiatry recognised by the National Medical Commission and preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as resident medical officer or house physicians in a hospital attached to a medical college permitted by the Central Government or Commission.

B) Qualifications for Teaching Staff of post-graduate medical institution shall be as follows, namely:-

1. PROFESSOR:- Homoeopathic subjects namely, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine and Homoeopathic Philosophy, Homoeopathic Pharmacy and Homoeopathic Repertory and Case taking, -

(A) Essential qualifications: The candidate, -

- (i) must possess recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned as an Associate Professor or not less than ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution;
- (ii) must have published two original publications as Principal author or Co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal.

(B) Desirable qualifications : The candidate may have, -

- (i) experience of not less than five years as supervisor or guide for post-graduate programme in Homoeopathy; or
- (ii) administrative experience of not less than three years in a homoeopathic medical college or hospital; or
- (iii) research experience in a research institution recognised by the University concerned and or the State Government or the Central Government, or in a project registered with Clinical Trial Registry -India.



2. PROFESSOR:- Practice of Medicine, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Community medicine and Dermatology,-

(A) Essential qualification: The candidate,-

- (i) must possess recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned as an Associate Professor or not less than ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution of degree level or teachers holding above mentioned experience in the Department of Practice of Medicine shall be considered for appointment in the Department of Dermatology for a period of ten years from the date of publication of this regulation; or
post-graduate Medical Degree in the subject concerned recognised by the Medical Council of India or National Medical Commission with five years of teaching experience as Associate Professor in the subject concerned or ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Homoeopathic College or in a medical college permitted by the State or the Central Government; and
- (ii) having minimum two publications as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer- reviewed journal.



(B) Desirable qualification : The candidate may have,-

- (i) experience of not less than five years as supervisor or guide for post- graduate programme in Homoeopathy; or
- (ii) administrative experience of not less than three years in a homoeopathic medical college or hospital; or
- (iii) research experience in a research institution recognised by the University concerned and or the State Government or the Central Government, or in a project registered with Clinical Trial Registry -India.

3. PROFESSOR: Research Methodology and Biostatistics,-

(A) Essential qualification: The candidate,-

must possess recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned as an Associate Professor or not less than ten years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution and having minimum two publications as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer-reviewed journal; or
post-graduate degree in Medical Statistics or Biostatistics or Epidemiology or other relevant discipline of Research Methodology or Medical statistics with ten years of full time research experience in regular service in group "A" post in research institution recognised by the



concerned University or the State Government or the Central Government or Union territory Administration and having at least four original publications as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer-reviewed journal and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test from the date it is operational.

(B) Desirable qualification: The candidate may have,—

- (i) experience of not less than five years as supervisor or guide for post-graduate programme in Homoeopathy; or
- (ii) administrative experience of not less than three years in a homoeopathic medical college or hospital; or
- (iii) research experience in a research institution recognized by the University concerned and or the State Government or the Central Government, Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trial Registry -India.

4. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR: Homoeopathic philosophy, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Pharmacy and Homoeopathic Repertory,—

(A) Essential qualifications: The candidate shall have,—

recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution. Must have published at least one publication as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or

recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy in subject concerned with not less than five years of full time research experience in Teaching Institution or in Research Councils of the Central Government or the State Government or Union territory Administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publication in indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission; or

must have not less than five years of experience in regular service, after acquiring post-graduate qualification in concerned subject in the Central Government Health Services or the State Government health Services, Ministry of Ayush or full time five year of experience as medical officer in regular service after acquiring post-graduate qualification in the concerned subject in recognised Homoeopathy Medical Institute and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility test conducted by the Commission.

(B) Desirable qualifications: The candidate may have,—

- (i) experience of not less than three years as supervisor or co-supervisor or guide or co-guide for Post-graduate course in homoeopathy; or
- (ii) research experience in a research institution recognised by the University concerned or the State Government or Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.



5. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR : Practice of Medicine and Community medicines,—

(A) Essential qualification : The candidate shall have,—

recognised post-graduate qualification in homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognised homoeopathic medical institution and must have published at least one publication as principal or co-author in indexed or peer reviewed journal; or

post-graduate medical degree in the subject concerned recognised by the Medical Council of India or National Medical Commission with five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Homoeopathic Medical institution of degree level or in a medical college permitted by the Central Government or National Medical Commission and having minimum one publication as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer reviewed journal; or

recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy in subject concerned with not less than five years of full time research experience in Teaching Institution or in Research Councils of the Central Government or State Government or Union territory Administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publication in indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission; or

must have not less than five years of experience in regular service, after acquiring post-graduate qualification in subject concerned in the Central Government Health Services or the State Government health Services, Ministry of Ayush or full time five year of experience as medical officer in regular service after acquiring post- graduate qualification in the concerned subject in recognised Homoeopathy Medical Institute and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility test conducted by the Commission.

(B) Desirable qualification: The candidate may have,—



(i) experience of not less than three years as supervisor or co-supervisor or guide or co- guide for post-graduate course in homoeopathy; or

(ii) research experience in a research institution recognised by the University concerned or the State Government or the Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.

6. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR: Dermatology, Pediatrics and Psychiatry,—

(A) Essential qualification: The candidate shall have,—

recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Homoeopathic Medical institution of degree level and having minimum one publication as Principal or Co- author in an indexed or peer-reviewed journal or teachers holding post-graduate degree in practice of medicines and five years of teaching experience in the Department of practice of medicine shall also be considered for appointment in the Department of Dermatology or Pediatrics or Psychiatry for a period of ten years from the date of publication of this notification; or



post-graduate medical degree in the subject concerned recognised by the Medical Council of India or National Medical Commission with not less than five years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Homoeopathic Medical institution of degree level or in a medical college permitted by the Central Government or National Medical Commission and having minimum one publication as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer reviewed journal; or

recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy in subject concerned with not less than five years of fulltime research experience in Teaching Institution or in Research Councils of the Central Government or the State Government or the Union territory Administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publications as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test from the date it is operational; or

must have not less than five years of experience in regular service (after possessing post-graduate qualification in the subject concerned) in the Central Government Health Services or the State Government Health services, Ministry of Ayush, or not less than five years of experience as fulltime medical officer (after possessing post-graduate qualification in the concerned subject) in a recognised Homoeopathy Medical College and having minimum three publication as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer-reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test from the date it is operational.

(B) Desirable qualification: The candidate may have,–

- (i) experience of not less than three years as supervisor or co-supervisor or guide or co-guide for post-graduate course in homoeopathy; or
- (ii) research experience in a research institution recognised by the University concerned or the State Government or the Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.

7. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR: Research Methodology and Biostatistics,–

(A) Essential qualification: The candidate shall have,–

recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with not less than five years of teaching experience in a Homoeopathic Medical College and has additionally taught research methodology and has at least one publication as Principal or Co-author in an indexed or peer-reviewed journal; or

recognised post-graduate qualification in Homoeopathy or post-graduate degree in Medical Statistics or Biostatistics or Epidemiology or other relevant discipline of Research Methodology or Medical statistics with not less than five years of fulltime research experience in Teaching Institution or in a research institution recognised by the University concerned or the State Government or the Central Government or Union territory Administration with at least four original publications,– as Principal or Co-author in an indexed

or peer reviewed journals and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test from the date it is operational.

(B) Desirable qualification: The candidate may have,–

- (i) experience of not less than three years as supervisor or co-supervisor or guide or co- guide for post-graduate course in homoeopathy; or
- (ii) research experience in a research institution recognised by the University concerned or the State Government or the Central Government or Union territory Administration or in a project registered with Clinical Trials Registry-India.
